1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of unaudited standalone financial results of UTI Asset Management Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") for the quarter ended 30 June 2026 ("the Statement").
2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Company's management and approved by its Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 "*Interim Financial Reporting*" ("Ind AS 34"), prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013, and other accounting principles generally accepted in India and in compliance with Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ("Listing Regulations"). 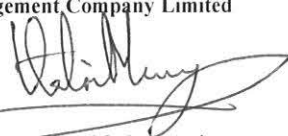

The figures up to the end of the third quarter of previous financial year had only been reviewed and not subjected to audit.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditors referred to in paragraph 7 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in the aforesaid Indian Accounting Standard and other accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of Regulation 33 of the Listing Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
7. We did not review the interim financial information of three subsidiaries included in the Statement, whose interim financial information reflects total revenues (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 55.45 crore, total net profit after tax (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 15.46 crore and total comprehensive income (before consolidation adjustments) of Rs. 15.36 crore, for the quarter ended 30 June 2026, as considered in the Statement. 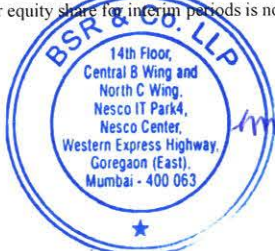
