‘Will end fast if students...

Otherwise, he would continue his fast indefinitely.

He said ministers also assured him of initiating a meaningful discussion in Parliament to ensure accountability, including consideration of the resignation of the Education Minister. He also expressed hope that excessive police force would not be used against the movement.

Wangchuk was admitted to Safdarjung Hospital on July 18 after Delhi Police shifted him from Jantar Mantar following 21 days of fasting in support of demands raised by the Cockroach Janta Party. His supporters have alleged he is under “illegal detention”, a charge denied by the authorities. He was later shifted to Medanta Hospital following a court order and continues to undergo treatment.

The Wheel of fortune...

Subsidies more than...

The increase included Rs 13,475 crore (253.55%) towards energy subsidy, Rs 6,670 crore for farmer welfare and agriculture development, Rs 1,510 crore for industrial policy and investment promotion, and Rs 1,144 crore for MSMEs. The CAG warned that rising subsidies reduce funds available for infrastructure and productive investment, increasing dependence on borrowings.

The report noted that 29.43% of total borrowings in 2024-25 were used to service past debt, leaving less for capital outlay. It also observed that debt has grown faster than the economy over the past three years.

During 2021-25, budget allocations increased every year, but expenditure never crossed 90% of the Budget. Departments surrendered Rs 20,620.16 crore on the last working day of the financial year, leaving no scope for reallocation.

Irregularities in hot...

During joint physical verification, the audit found that 13 SHGs in Alirajpur, Sehore and Tikamgarh had neither kitchens nor offices at the addresses mentioned in bills submitted to district programme officers. Sector supervisors pointed auditors to alternate locations, where male workers, who were not SHG members, were found preparing meals. The workers admitted they operated on behalf of SHGs and were paid between Rs 10,000 and Rs 13,000 a month. The audit also found no stock registers, utensil inventories, kitchen logs or daily consumption records. Meals for 132 anganwadi centres were supplied from these centralised kitchens, for which district programme officers paid Rs 4.1 crore.

HC accepts MLA Sanjay...

"Hence, we are inclined to accept the unconditional apology tendered by him," the order said. "However, we put a note of caution that a contemnor, who is Member of legislation, is expected not to repeat such an act and should be careful in future," the order said. Anurag Jain named NITI...

No consensus could reportedly be reached on appointing 1990-batch IAS officer Rajesh Rajora, who is senior to Barnwal. With Barnwal's appointment, Rajora is now expected to be posted outside the Mantralaya.

Jain was appointed chief secretary in October 2024 and was granted a one-year extension on Aug 31, 2025, extending his tenure until Aug 31, 2026. However, he has now been appointed CEO of NITI Aayog before completing his extended term. He is regarded as an officer trusted by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and is the first officer from Madhya Pradesh to head NITI Aayog as its CEO.

Before his appointment, Barnwal was serving as additional chief secretary in the Health Department. During his career, he has held key positions in the Forest Department, served as agriculture production commissioner and handled several important departments. He has served as principal secretary to former chief ministers Shivraj Singh Chouhan and Kamal Nath, besides serving in the Chief Minister's Secretariat during Uma Bharti's tenure. Barnwal is known for his efficient administrative style.

AI system goes rogue...

The primary lesson from this incident is that model security and safety must keep pace with rapidly advancing capabilities." TEMPLE CEO POST DRAWS 5,200 APPLICATIONS

New Delhi: A total of 5,200 applications have been received for the post of Chief Executive Officer (CEO) in the Shri Ram Janmabhoomi Teerth Kshetra Trust, and the selection process is expected to be completed in a month, said temple officials after the special meeting on Wednesday.

The Temple Trust held a special meeting inside the temple complex in Ayodhya on Wednesday, for finalis-

ing the appointment of a new General Secretary, filling three vacant Trustee posts and also the Ram Mandir's first CEO amid the donation misappropriation row.

Briefing the newsmen about the meeting outcome, the Temple Trust's interim General Secretary Krishna Mohan said that the overwhelming number of applications were received for the CEO post.

Without statehood, Article 370 is meaningless, says Omar

A day after he led a protest in the national capital seeking restoration of statehood for Jammu and Kashmir, Chief Minister and National Conference vice-president Omar Abdullah emphasised that the demand for statehood is foundational to restore constitutional guarantees to J&K.

"What does (Article) 370 or 371 mean without statehood? A union territory has no powers. There is no state list or a concurrent list and that is the whole fight. Any special status that is accorded to J&K - whether it is 370 or something else - it will come down to how the Centre and state share power and the Centre does not share power with a UT," the chief minister said on Tuesday in reference to criti-

cism that the NC is restricting its protest to statehood and not discussing the restoration of constitutional guarantees under Article 370.

He said Delhi police offered Ramila Maidan, "but we rejected it."

‘Omar pouring acid on hopes of J&K’s people’

PDP chief Mehbooba Mufti on Wednesday said that Omar Abdullah "ruling out" the re-statement of Article 370 was like pouring acid on the hopes of the people of Jammu and Kashmir, trying to instil a sense of defeat among them.

"Stating that (Article) 370 will not return is like throwing acid on the hopes of the people of J-K, which should not be done. He (Abdullah) wants to instil a sense of defeat among people, which I don't think any leader should do.. It is not right," Mehbooba said.

SC seeks reply from six rebel Sena MPs

The Supreme Court on Wednesday issued notices to the Lok Sabha Speaker's office and six rebel Shiv Sena (UBT) MPs on a plea filed by Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Arvind Sawant challenging the Speaker's decision recognising the merger with the Eknath Shinde-led Shiv Sena under the anti-defection law.

A Bench of Justices P.S. Narasimha and Alok Aradhe sought responses from the respondents and posted the matter for further hearing after two weeks.

The notices were issued to the Lok Sabha Speaker, the Joint Secretary and six MPs—Bhausaheb Waghchaure, Nagesh Patil Ashtikar, Omprakash Rajee Nimbalkar, Sanjay Bandu Jadhav, Sanjay Deshmukh and Sanjay Dina Patil.

However, the apex court declined to stay Lok Sabha Speaker

Om Birla's decision recognising the merger of the six MPs with the Shinde faction.

The petition, filed by Sawant, contends that the Speaker's decision has severely affected the functioning of the Shiv Sena (UBT) as a political party in Parliament by reducing its strength in the Lok Sabha from nine MPs to three following the recognition of the merger.

Sawant has challenged the constitutional validity of the Speaker's decision recognising the merger under Paragraph 4 of the Tenth Schedule, arguing that no merger of the original political party had taken place and, therefore, the legislature party could not claim the benefit of the merger provision to escape disqualification under the anti-defection law.

The dispute traces its origins to the defection of six of the nine Shiv Sena (UBT) Lok Sabha MPs, who approached the Lok Sabha Speaker seek-

Teacher detained over obscene chats with student

Patna: The mathematics teacher of a private school was detained on Wednesday after being accused of allegedly sending obscene messages to a Class 7 student, triggering outrage among parents and local residents.

According to police, the accused was caught by the student's family members and local residents near the school.

After being assaulted by the crowd, he was handed over to the Bhagwan Bazar Police Station.

The incident led to commotion in the area for some time. The student's parents have lodged a formal complaint with the police, alleging that the teacher had repeatedly sent objectionable and inappropriate messages to the minor's mobile phone.

Raids intensify after Anantnag attack

Following the terror attack in J&K's Anantnag town in which one local policeman was killed, police intensified raids across the Valley on Wednesday and over 3,000 Over Ground Workers (OGWs) of terrorist outfits were rounded up.

Senior officials said security forces have intensified raids across the Kashmir Valley, picking up over 3,000 OGWs after a cop was killed in a terror attack in south Kashmir's Anantnag district.

J&K Police along with security forces launched Valleywide raids. Officials said during the raids over 3,000 OGWs were picked up even as search operations were intensified at several places, including Anantnag district.

PK aide's hotel searched amid bypoll campaign

Police on Wednesday conducted searches at a hotel owned by Ravi Narayan Singh, a close associate of Jan Suraj Party (JSP) founder Prashant Kishor, amid the high-voltage campaign for the Bankipur Assembly by-election.

Singh, the JSP's state secretary, alleged that police were targeting party leaders and workers by searching his hotels and the residences of party workers.

Kishor is contesting the bypoll against BJP's Neeraj Kumar Sinha and RJD's Rekha Gupta.

Singh claimed police demanded old guest registers and threatened to seal his properties and send him to

jail. He said he had assured officers that the older records would be retrieved from a secondary administrative office within 10 days, but they still warned of legal action.

Meanwhile, a high-level JSP delegation led by state president Manoj Bharti met the Bihar Chief Electoral Officer and submitted a memorandum alleging violations of the Model Code of Conduct and harassment of party workers by police.

Bharti alleged that the administrative machinery was being misused in the Bankipur Assembly constituency to intimidate Jan Suraj workers. He claimed police were visiting the homes of party workers in Patna and other parts of Bihar without any FIR being registered.



Yatra security duty, was shot dead by a terrorist in Anantnag's Lal Chowk around 12.30 p.m. on Tuesday.

Following the attack, forces launched a massive manhunt and cordoned off the entire Anantnag town to trace the attacker. J&K LG Manoj Sinha and Chief Minister Omar Abdullah condemned the attack, calling it a cowardly act and offering condolences to the bereaved family.
