# Vasai: Judge mulls container courts

Lawyers in Vasai have called off a protest planned for July 27, after Thane Principal District Judge Rajendra Dattaram Sawant directed the Public Works Department to urgently submit a feasibility report on setting up temporary container-style courtrooms at the court site earmarked for a proposed permanent building.

Officials estimate that up to 10 makeshift courtrooms can function from the site.

The Bar Association of



Vasai and the Vasai Advocates Association had called for a sit-in demonstration outside the Vasai court premises on July 27, against shortage of judges at the Vasai court, concerns about time spent in recording witness statements under Section 164 of the Criminal Procedure Code, and alleg-

tions of systemic corruption.

Judge Sawant visited Vasai on July 23 and summoned representatives of the advocates' associations for extended discussions. The representatives said that while the Vasai court requires at least 40 judges to manage its heavy caseload, only 15 judges are posted

there.

Noel Dabre, an advocate practicing in the Vasai court said: "The judge said that once the containers are ready for use, the number of judges can be increased." But it is not clear how many new judges will be appointed.

On concerns that recording witness statements under Section 164 consumes entire working days, Judge Sawant said: "I will immediately call a meeting of judges and direct that Section 164 statement recordings be scheduled after 4 pm."

The lawyers' delegation

also raised serious allegations of systemic corruption, stating that case files frequently go missing, after which money is allegedly demanded under the pretext of "tracing" them. Judge Sawant assured them of strict disciplinary measures.

The delegation also voiced concern over the alleged disrespectful conduct of some judges towards junior lawyers, delays in the delivery of orders, and instances of investigating officers leaving court without permission during bail hearings, keeping matters pending indefinitely.

## Youth drowns in Powai's Vihar lake

A 19-year-old youth, identified as Kailash Soman, drowned in Vihar Lake in Powai on Thursday. The exact circumstances leading to the incident are yet to be ascertained. The incident was reported at around 3.18 pm after the BMC's Mumbai Fire Brigade received information. The fire brigade immediately launched a search operation, with teams from the Powai Police and BMC ward staff also rushing to the spot. Rescue personnel are continuing the search operation in the lake. Further legal procedures and an investigation into the circumstances of the incident, including why the victim visited the lake, will be initiated after the body is recovered.

## 80-yr-old who lost kin in Irshalwadi saves two siblings

Police and villagers, including an 80-year-old man who lost five family members in the 2023 Irshalwadi landslide, rescued two siblings from Irshalgad Fort in Maharashtra on Wednesday, where they were stranded due to inclement weather.

The siblings, identified as Nikhil Santosh Shinde, 22, and Tanmay Ravindra Shinde, 17, residents of Chendani Koliwada in Thane, found themselves stranded following torrential rain, strong winds and poor visibility. Unable to descend safely, they called the emergency helpline 112.

Chouk Assistant Police Inspector Sandeep Shingte immediately coordinated a rescue operation with local police and villagers familiar with the terrain.

80-year-old Kamalu Pardi established contact with the stranded siblings, and along with other rescuers, climbed the rain-soaked fort to bring them down safely without injuries.

"The siblings did the right thing by not attempting to descend on their own and instead calling the emergency helpline," Shingte said. "The prompt response from local villagers, who know the terrain well, helped us complete

the rescue safely and quickly despite adverse weather conditions."

The rescue came just days after the third anniversary of the July 19, 2023 Irshalwadi landslide, which killed dozens of people. Pardi has participated in rescue and search operations across the region following the tragedy.

A representative of the Help Foundation, which is involved in rescue and relief activities in the Matheran-Irshalgad region, said: "Kamalu Pardi's courage and selfless commitment continue to inspire everyone. Despite suffering an unimaginable personal loss, he never hesitates to help others in distress. The dedication shown by Kaustubh Kumbhar and the local volunteers once again proves that these rescues are possible because of the unwavering support of the local community."

Khalapur Police Inspector Sachin Pawar said Pardi and other rescuers, including Kaustubh Kumbhar and Avishkar Patil, would be felicitated.

## Shatabdi Hosp to start chemo ward by Sept

The BMC is set to launch a dedicated chemotherapy ward at the Bharat Ratna Dr Babasaheb Ambedkar Shatabdi Hospital in Kandivali, bringing treatment for cancer patients in Mumbai's western suburbs closer to home.

The facility is expected to become operational from September, offering relief to patients who currently travel to Tata Memorial Hospital in Parel for treatment.

Confirming the development, Dr Ajay Gupta, Medical Superintendent of Shatabdi Hospital said: "The required infrastructure and administrative preparations are underway, and we are planning to start the service from September."

Hospital authorities have begun the process of procuring equipment, stocking essential medicines and deploying trained oncologists and nursing staff. The ward will be commissioned after all technical and administrative formalities are completed.

At present, a large number of cancer patients from Borivali, Kandivali, Malad, Goregaon and adjoining western suburbs depend on Tata Memorial Hospital in Parel for chemotherapy.

The new facility is expected to significantly reduce travel time, transportation costs and waiting periods for patients and their families.

## Metro 2B: Bandra ROB pier segment

The MMRDA has installed the first 70-tonne back-span pier segment of the Bandra Railway Over Bridge (ROB) of Mumbai Metro Line 2B.

The 200-metre-long bridge is being constructed across the Western Express Highway and the Western Railway corridor near Bandra railway station. Officials said the segment was installed without dis-

rupting either railway or vehicular movement. The cable-stayed bridge forms a crucial part of the 23.6-km Metro Line 2B corridor connecting DN Nagar with Mandale. According to MMRDA, the bridge features a 104-metre main span supported by back spans. The project also includes two pylons rising 20.1 metres above ground. Construction will now progress to erecting the remaining steel superstructure.

## Citizens' group urges govt for env norms in Film City redvpt

A citizens' group has urged the Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change to ensure that the proposed redevelopment of the Dadasaheb Phalke Chitranagari (Film City) at Goregaon complies with all environmental laws, particularly those governing the Eco-Sensitive Zone (ESZ) of the adjoining Sanjay Gandhi National Park (SGNP).

The Watchdog Foundation on Thursday submitted a representation to Union Environment Minister Bhupender Yadav and senior ministry officials, expressing concern over the proposed redevelopment of the 521-acre government-owned campus.

The NGO requested the ministry to ascertain whether the redevelopment falls wholly or partly within the notified ESZ surrounding SNGP, and to ensure that no environmental clearance or approval is granted without

full compliance with statutory provisions.

The representation stated that any redevelopment involving expansion, change in land use, construction of new infrastructure or increase in built-up area should be examined in accordance with relevant acts and notifications. It also called for adherence to directions issued by the Supreme Court, the National Green Tribunal and other judicial forums concerning protected areas.

Godfrey Pimenta, trustee of the foundation, also called for a comprehensive assessment of the redevelopment's potential impact on wildlife habitats, ecological corridors, hydrology, biodiversity, vegetation, traffic, noise, light pollution and cumulative environmental effects. The foundation further urged the ministry to examine whether the project requires appraisal by the appropriate Expert Appraisal Committee, the Standing Committee of the National Board for Wildlife or any other statutory authority.

## All-India Agrawal matrimonial meet set to bring eligible youth together
