Judge recuses from hearing Gadling plea
Supreme Court Justice Shree Chandrashekhar on Tuesday recused himself from hearing the bail plea of advocate Surendra Gadling, accused in the 2018 Elgar Parishad-Maoist links case.
Gadling's petition was listed before a bench comprising Justices Prashant Kumar Mishra and Chandrashekhar.

Fresh police protection for 'Kumbh girl'
The Kerala High Court on Tuesday again ordered protection by Palarivattom police station till the next date of hearing on July 28 for the young girl who shot to fame after a video of her at the Prayagraj Kumbh Mela went viral, after she claimed that different groups of people were following her and circulating information about her location.

SC suggests surrender by honeymoon case accused
The Supreme Court on Tuesday suggested that Sonam Raghuvanshi, the prime accused in the Raja Raghuvanshi honeymoon murder case, consider surrendering and face trial pending the examination of key prosecution witnesses.
"We don't want to catch you by surprise. Either we will consider and pass an order on merits, or we will pass an order making you surrender," the court said orally.

Rijiju said Modi stressed that those guilty of paper leaks should receive the strictest possible punishment and that the government would use every legal avenue, with the support of the country's top lawyers, to ensure exemplary action against those involved. 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Fadnavis attacks...

Backing Fadnavis, Maharashtra BJP president and Revenue Minister Chandrashekhar Bawankule dismissed the agitation as a "nau-tank" (drama), alleging that public outrage over examination irregularities was being politically orchestrated.
The Opposition, however, accused the BJP of suppressing a legitimate students' movement. Shiv Sena (UBT) leader Aaditya Thackeray alleged that the Centre had unleashed police brutality on students, claiming that women and children were lathi-charged during the march towards Parliament. He criticised Fadnavis for attributing the violence to anti-social elements, saying the "faceless" students' movement had unnerved the BJP. Thackeray also announced legal assistance for students facing police action and said Shiv Sena (UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray would visit Jantar Mantar on Wednesday to meet the protesters.
Adding weight to the Opposition's support, NCP (SP) president Sharad Pawar visited Jantar Mantar, met CJP founder Abhijit Dipke and extended solidarity with the agitation, intensifying the political confrontation over the nationwide protests demanding accountability for the alleged examination irregularities.

'This is gundagardi...'

Dhyani was detained on July 19 after posting on Facebook that he would join the Delhi protest in support of activist Sonam Wangchuk. He was intercepted at Rishikesh railway station, later traced to Ramnagar Police Station in Nainital district and released within 24 hours.
The Bench questioned the Uttarakhand Police's role, asking, "Who are you? You are not Delhi Police! He has right to move anywhere in the country. What territorial jurisdiction did you have here?"
Reading from the police records, Justice Maithani remarked, "This is gundagardi... What lawful direction you have? You don't go to Delhi, you don't go to join the march! Delhi Police will take care of it. Who are you to stop?... Are you here to protect image of government or constitutional right of an individual? The way Police is behaving is absurd."
When the State referred to national security, the court responded, "This is not national security. In the name of national security and sarkaar

Hate speech case: Mahua gets interim protection

The Calcutta High Court on Tuesday granted interim protection from coercive action to Trinamool Congress MP Mahua Moitra till October 5 in a "hate speech" case registered at Hoggolberia police station in Nadia district, which she said is fabricated.
Justice Saugata Bhattacharyya directed Moitra to appear before the investigating officer on August 14 for questioning in the case, and to comply with police notices.
The matter will be heard again on October 1.

SC asks AIIMS for Asaram's medical report

The Supreme Court on Tuesday asked the director of AIIMS to constitute a medical board to assess the condition of self-styled godman Asaram, who has sought interim bail on medical grounds.
The Rajasthan High Court on May 27 upheld the conviction and life sentence awarded to the octogenarian in a case of rape of a minor in 2013.
A bench of justices M M Sundresh and P B Varale asked the medical board to submit its report within a week.
During the hearing, Solicitor General Tushar Mehta submitted that just three months ago Asaram undertook journeys to Kashi Vishwanath and Ayodhya, though claiming that he was in a vegetative state.
"We are not granting regular bail except if we are satisfied it is required on a medical ground," the bench said.

Patna HC raises voice on 'Nazi-style policing'

Court orders FIR against former Bihar SHO who assaulted a man in Buxar after ascertaining his caste

The Patna High Court has ordered the registration of an FIR against a former Station House Officer (SHO) of Murar Police Station in Bihar's Buxar district over the alleged custodial assault and warned against "Nazi Germany-style" policing.
Directing the Criminal Investigation Department (CID) to investigate allegations of custodial assault, the HC warned that unchecked police brutality could undermine the rule of law.
Hearing a petition filed by Manish Kumar, Justice Jitendra Kumar observed that if such conduct by the police was allowed to continue, the constitutional guarantee of life and personal liberty would be rendered meaningless.
"If such conduct by the police is not curbed and controlled, the rule of law and the

constitutional protection of citizens' lives and liberty in this country will cease to exist. The national police force could turn into something like that of Nazi Germany," the court said.
The court directed the immediate registration of an FIR against Kamal Nayan Pandey, the then SHO of Murar Police Station, and ordered that the investigation be transferred to the Bihar Police's CID to ensure an impartial probe.
According to the petition, Kumar, a resident of Ganghar village in Bhojpur district, had gone to a friend's shop in Chaugain village in Buxar on July 4, 2024. Around 2 pm, a police vehicle from Murar Police Station reached the spot.
Kumar alleged that Pandey asked for his name and caste and, after learning his caste, along with other policemen, verbally abused him and assaulted him with lathis,

leaving him with fractures in both legs.
Police denied the allegations, claiming before the court that Kumar had slipped during rainy weather and sustained the injuries in the fall.
Rejecting the explanation, the High Court relied on X-ray reports and other material on record, observing that the injuries were inconsistent with the police's version. The court also held that a brutal assault by a police officer on a citizen cannot be treated as an act performed in the discharge of official duties.

Aravalli panel opens 21-day window for feedback

The Supreme Court-constituted Aravalli committee has invited representations from people on issues related to the Aravalli hill range.
Formed on May 25, the high-powered committee has been tasked with conducting an independent review of the Centre's report on the definition and delineation of the Aravalli hill range.
The development has come amid concerns about the committee's neutrality, as it mainly comprises ex-government officers.
The committee, which has to submit its report by August 31, is headed by Kanchan Devi, Director General of the Indian Council of Forestry Research and Education.
Critics argue that as the committee's head reports directly to the Environment Ministry, it does not satisfy the criteria of either impartiality or independence as stated in the apex court's suo moto order of December 2025.

HC refuses to stay bail in UAPA case

New Delhi: The Delhi High Court on Tuesday refused to stay the bail granted to Kashmiri human rights activist Khuram Parvez and journalist Irfan Mehraj in a 2020 case registered under the anti-terror law UAPA.
The counsel for the National Investigation Agency (NIA) sought a stay on the trial court's bail order, passed on July 18, on the grounds that the case pertained to serious offences and that the relief given to the two accused persons was "bereft of any reasoning".
The MIA counsel also argued that the bail order would have a "chilling effect" and "create a problem" by being cited as a precedent in other cases.
Both were arrested in March 2023.

Juvenile can be tried as adult for murder: SC

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Tuesday held that a juvenile accused of murder can be tried as an adult if statutory requirements are met, as such a crime is a "heinous offence" under juvenile justice law.
A bench comprising justices JB Pardiwala and Ujjal Bhuyan made the observations while dismissing a juvenile's appeal against a Patna High Court verdict allowing his trial as an adult for murder.
The judgement, aimed at clarifying the legal framework for trying minors as adults, ruled that murder (Section 302 of the IPC) must be classified as a "heinous offence" under the Juvenile Justice (Care and Protection of Children) Act.
The 16-year-old allegedly slit a boy's throat in Bihar.
The high court had held that there was a need for trial of the appellant as an adult, and accordingly directed transfer of the trial to a regular court.
