Upset SC Calls for Special Courts in Manipur Violence

Directs agencies to expedite pending investigations

New Delhi: The Supreme Court on Friday indicated that it plans to constitute special courts to conduct day-to-day trials of cases connected to the ethnic violence in Manipur and directed investigating agencies to expedite pending investigations. A three-judge bench headed by Chief Justice of India (CJI) Surya Kant directed the Manipur government to extend full cooperation to the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) and Special Investigation

Teams (SITs), which are facing various difficulties in completing the probes. "We tentatively propose to constitute special courts, probably in consultation with the State of Manipur and the High Court of Manipur and Gauhati High Court, so that the trials can be taken up on a day-to-day basis, especially in light of the inordinate delay that has already taken place in the ongoing investigations," CJI Kant said. He added, "This will be possible only when the CBI as well as the SITs are able to conclude the investigations and file their respective charge sheets. We, therefore, urge both the agencies to do their best, despite the impediments, and complete the investigations." During the hearing, the bench noted that the SITs are investigating



3,020 cases across eight districts, but charge sheets have been filed in only 301 cases. It added that charges have been framed in 41 cases and trials have commenced in 10. A total of 2,924 witnesses has been cited in these cases. Meanwhile, the CBI said it has filed charge sheets in 21 of the 31 cases

transferred to it, while supplementary investigation is underway in 11 cases. It also submitted that closure reports have been filed in six cases, of which three have been accepted. The remaining four cases are still under investigation. The CBI further highlighted the challenges hampering the probes.

"Witnesses are refusing to cooperate due to mistrust. There are language barriers because of the existence of numerous regional dialects, posing a significant impediment to effective communication with local residents and witnesses," the federal agency submitted before the court.

Three-member Team Formed to Probe Ex-Tripura DGP's Death

Guwahati: Tripura director general of police (DGP) on Friday constituted a three-member team to probe the 'mysterious' death of former DGP Anurag Dhanekar, whose body was found at the state police headquarters here on July 20, officials said. An order issued by the office of the DGP said that superintendent of police (West Tripura) Namit Patra would head the probe team. Additional superintendent of police (Urban), West Tripura, Dhruva Nath, and sub-inspector Subhojit Deb, who is currently investigating the 'unnatural death' case, are the other two members of the team. The order stated that, if required, the SP (West) may co-opt any other officer from the Tripura Police Crime Branch or any other unit, as deemed appropriate. For technical support, the SP (West) may seek assistance from the Cyber Crime Unit of the Tripura Police Crime Branch. Progress reports on the investigation shall be submitted weekly to the inspector general of police (Law and Order), Tripura, for the perusal of the DGP. Dhanekar's body was found under mysterious circumstances in the washroom attached to his official chamber at the state police headquarters in Agartala. The opposition CPI (M), CPI, Congress and several other political parties have demanded a judicial inquiry, monitored by a sitting judge of the Tripura HC to ascertain the circumstances and reasons behind the death. —Our Political Bureau



Assam Toll Rises to 47; CM Himanta Terms It 'Unusual'

Guwahati: Assam chief minister Himanta Biswa Sarma said 47 people have died in the current wave of floods, while eight remain missing. Sarma told reporters that exceptionally heavy rainfall in Nagaland's Mokokchung, Wokha and Mon districts, along with Charaideo in Assam, between July 18 and July 20 triggered the floods. "Mokokchung alone recorded 480% above normal rainfall," he said. "Wokha recorded 108% above normal while Mon received 45% above normal rainfall. Charaideo district simultaneously recorded 436% above normal rainfall while neighbouring Sivasagar received 134% above normal rainfall." Sarma said the flooding was particularly severe because water from Nagaland flowed downstream even as Charaideo was receiving extremely heavy rainfall. When we analysed the situation, we found that floodwaters from Charaideo could not flow into the Brahmaputra because the river itself was overflowing," he said. The chief minister said the India Meteorological Department

had ruled out a cloudburst in Nagaland. "The IMD has informed us that there was no cloudburst. Technically it was an episode of extremely heavy rainfall. Politically one may compare it to a cloudburst because the impact was similar, but scientifically it was excessive rainfall." Sarma described the floods as unusual. "Generally, in Assam, first we see the river swelling and gradually we prepare. This time waters came gushing and there was hardly any time for evacuation." An inter-ministerial team will visit Assam on July 25 to assess flood damage. The team recently visited Dhemaji and Lakhimpur. Sarma, who was camping in the flood-affected areas, said rescue teams were yet to reach about 80,000 people in the two districts. "There are 40,000 people without electricity," he added.



Three Killed in Palghar, Over 1,100 Evacuated

Palghar: Heavy rains over the last two days have claimed at least three lives in Maharashtra's coastal Palghar district, cutting off several villages and forcing the administration to evacuate 1,155 people, officials said on Friday. A relief team official described the flood situation as the worst the district has faced in ten years. Rains eased a little on Friday, but schools and educational institutions in the district have been directed to remain closed, officials said. PTI



Heavy Rains Lash Rajasthan; Red Alert in Two Districts

Jaipur: Heavy rainfall lashed several parts of Rajasthan on Friday, with Pachpadra in Balotra district and Amet in Rajsamand recording the highest rainfall of 9 cm each during the past 24 hours, officials said. The IMD issued a red alert for Banswara and Dungarpur districts, an orange alert for nine districts and a yellow warning for the remaining districts on Friday. Rail services on the Mumbai route were affected after rising water levels near Bridge No. 203 between Gholvad and Umargam Road stations on the Western Railway led to the suspension of train movement. —PTI

Army Rescues 100 in Rain-Hit Ahmedabad

Ahmedabad: At least 100 residents were rescued by the Indian Army from Ahmedabad city's upscale Bopal area on Friday amid extremely heavy rain lashing Gujarat over the past few days, officials said. Bopal area received 491 millimetres of rainfall in a 36-hour period from 6 am on Thursday to 12 noon on Friday. Two Army flood relief teams, equipped with four trucks and four boats, were deployed at Chhinalal Joshi Marg in Bopal area to evacuate stranded residents, defence PRO wing commander Abhishek Tiwari said. Chief minister Bhupendra Patel also visited flood-hit Bopal, walked through water-logged streets and reviewed the ongoing rescue, relief and drainage operations. —PTI

Heavy Rains Swell Rivers in J&K

Srinagar: Intermittent rainfall in parts of Jammu and Kashmir has swollen major rivers and streams, triggering a flood scare across the Union Territory. The Srinagar-Jammu highway, which connects the Valley with the rest of the country, remained closed for the third consecutive day as flash floods, landslides and shooting stones damaged the 250-km road at several places. Hundreds of trucks and private vehicles remained stranded on the highway, with passengers waiting for the road to reopen till late Thursday night. The administration said the ongoing Amarnath, Mata Vaishno Devi, Shiv Khori and Machail pilgrimages would continue to remain suspended, advising pilgrims to stay at designated base camps and lodging centres. In Kashmir, the river Jhelum and its tri-

butaries, including the Lidder and Vishu, were flowing above the danger mark for most of the day, and some low-lying areas were submerged. The Irrigation and Flood Control Department is closely monitoring the situation and has advised people to exercise utmost caution. According to the Meteorological Department, the ongoing spell of rain over south Kashmir and adjoining areas is likely to continue intermittently till Friday afternoon, after which conditions are expected to improve gradually. However, another spell of wet weather is forecast across the region from July 28 to 31. In Jammu, relentless rain, cloudbursts and flash floods over the past six days have claimed 26 lives, while six people remain missing. Rescue teams have intensified the search for the missing in the worst-hit border districts of Poonch and Rajouri, deploying additional personnel to scan flood channels and vulnerable areas.

Two Fugitives Deported to India from Gulf Nations

New Delhi: The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) on Friday said it has secured the deportation of two fugitives — Mohammedali Kanneer Palliyalil and Avinash Arjun Rathod — from Gulf countries in coordination with external affairs and home ministries and the National Investigation Agency (NIA). Palliyalil, deported from Saudi Arabia on Thursday, was wanted for murder while Rathod, deported from the United Arab Emirates on the same day, was wanted in a case involving large-scale financial fraud, CBI said. Palliyalil, now arrested by NIA for unlawful

activities and murder, along with his associates in furtherance of the larger conspiracy, unlawfully assembled with deadly weapons and assailants criminally trespassed into the shop of a victim, wrongfully restrained him and inflicted grievous injuries by using lethal weapons and killed him, the statement said. Rathod was taken into custody by a team of Maharashtra Police on arrival at Mumbai airport. "In criminal conspiracy with others, the subject induced investors to invest in multiple schemes by falsely promising assured fixed monthly returns. The subject dishonestly misappropriated the funds and diverted the proceeds through multiple bank accounts and demat accounts. Earlier, a Red Notice was published against the subject through Interpol," CBI said. —Our Political Bureau

Indian Crew Member Killed in Black Sea Attack

New Delhi: A commercial vessel, MV OM-ORFI, was allegedly attacked by Ukraine while transiting the Black Sea this week, reportedly in Russian territorial waters. Ten crew members, including three Indian nationals, were on board at the time of the incident. One Indian national lost his life in the attack, while the other two on board are reported to be safe, as per an MEA statement. On receiving the information, the Indian Mission in Russia reached out to the relevant authorities and is making efforts to extend all possible assistance to the affected family. —OPB

Mumbai-Ahmedabad Flooding Dominates BRICS Meet

New Delhi: The recent urban flooding in Mumbai, Ahmedabad and Surat was discussed at the BRICS Ministerial Meeting on Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) in New Delhi on Friday. The National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) presented urban flood mitigation plans and preparedness measures adopted by municipal authorities. NDMA member Dr Krishna S. Vatsa said the authorities in Delhi have devised SOPs for the upcoming monsoon season. BRICS comprises Brazil, Russia, India, China and South Africa. The ministerial meeting featured a high-level policy dialogue on 'Advancing Climate-Smart and Disaster-Resilient Infrastructure Systems: Partnerships, Innovation and Financing for Resilient Development', where ministers deliberated on resilient infrastructure, innovative financing, emerging technologies and international partnerships to address increasing disaster and climate risks. A ministerial roundtable on 'Accelerating Implementation of the BRICS

Disaster Risk Reduction Work Plan (2025-2030)' enabled member countries to exchange experiences and identify practical pathways for strengthening institutional cooperation, capacity building, knowledge sharing and implementation of the agreed priorities. As part of India's chairship, six flagship knowledge products were launched to support evidence-based policymaking, institutional strengthening, capacity building and practical implementation of disaster risk reduction initiatives across BRICS member countries, the NDMA said in a statement.

As the way forward, the ministers emphasised strengthening practical and action-oriented cooperation through regular technical exchanges, joint projects, simulation exercises, expert exchanges and annual thematic workshops to promote knowledge sharing, innovation and measurable outcomes in disaster resilience. —Our Political Bureau

B'desh PM Invited as BIMSTEC Chair amid India Outreach to Regional Blocs

New Delhi: India, the current BRICS chair, is contemplating inviting key regional organisations, including BIMSTEC, ASEAN and the Arab League, as part of the outreach initiative for the summit to be held in New Delhi on September 12-13. The government is exploring a proposal to invite the current chairs of ASEAN, BIMSTEC, the League of Arab States, the Gulf Cooperation Council (GCC), the Eurasian Economic Union (EAEU) and the African Union as part of the outreach initiative for the BRICS Summit to champion the agenda of the Global South, ET has learnt. Bangladesh PM Tarique Rahman could visit India for the summit, as the country is the current chair of BIMSTEC. Similarly, the Philippine President could visit New Delhi, with the Philippines

serving as the current ASEAN chair. Kazakhstan is the current chair of the EAEU, and the Kazakh President is also expected to attend the summit as a BRICS Partner country. While the League of Arab States has its headquarters in Cairo, the Egyptian President is also expected to attend the summit as Egypt is a BRICS member. Burundi currently chairs the African Union. The rotating presidency of the Supreme Council of the GCC is currently held by the United Arab Emirates, whose leadership is also expected to attend the summit as a BRICS member. Besides the 11 BRICS members, all 10 BRICS partner countries are expected to attend the summit. Inviting countries and regional groupings beyond BRICS partners is a prerogative of the chairing country, and Russia, Brazil and China have undertaken similar outreach initiatives in the past.
