PM SPEAKS TO CM TO REVIEW RESCUE EFFORTS

10 Dead, Several Trapped in Sikkim Tunnel Collapse; Rescue Ops On

Suspected methane gas burst caused explosion, generating toxic fumes: NHPC

Guwahati: Ten people were killed while several others remained trapped after an under-construction tunnel collapsed due to a landslide in Sikkim's Namchi district a day ago, officials said on Tuesday.

A total of 25 people, including project officials and workers, were trapped inside the tunnel when it collapsed on Monday. "Ten bodies have been recovered so far. Seven of the deceased have been identified, while three unidentified bodies were sent to District Hospital Singtam and STNM Hospital," Namchi Police said in a statement.

NHPC Limited, in a statement on Tuesday, said, "An unfortunate incident occurred at 1:04 pm on July 20 inside the under-construction Head Race Tunnel of NHPC Teesta Stage-VI Hydroelec-

tric Project, Samardung, South Sikkim, after a sudden burst of suspected methane gas trapped within the rocks led to an explosion, generating dense fumes and toxic gases. The project team immediately activated its emergency response protocols. The team is working in close

coordination with the district administration, National Disaster Response Force, State Disaster Response Force, local authorities and other emergency agencies to support the ongoing rescue operations. In addition, a special rescue team from DG Mines Safety has also re-

ched the site."

The company added, "As per the latest information from the site, 25 personnel were trapped inside the tunnel, of whom 10 have been confirmed dead so far." NHPC said a detailed investigation will be undertaken to ascertain the cause of the incident. Sikkim chief minister Prem Singh Tamang said the tunnel at Samardung in Jholungey caved in due to a landslide.

Tamang said Prime Minister Narendra Modi spoke with him and enquired about the rescue operations. "Following the inquiry, if any fault or negligence on the part of the company is found, appropriate action will be taken. The state government will also provide ₹4 lakh as compensation to the families of the deceased and ₹50,000 to the injured. There were 27 people inside the tunnel, of whom two managed to escape," he said.

Diplomacy Alive Even as US, Iran Keep up Attack on Day 10

Pakistan tries to play peacemaker again with Iranian interior minister Momeni's visit

Islamabad: US forces bombed Iran's south and west after President Donald Trump said Tehran would pay dearly for the deaths of American soldiers, while Iran targeted US sites in Bahrain, Kuwait and Jordan on Tuesday and a tanker was hit in the Strait of Hormuz.

US Central Command said it had hit Iranian military command centres, maritime capabilities, missile and drone launch sites, and air defence systems in its latest round of strikes. Also on Tuesday, diplomats sought to salvage the collapsed interim deal between the warring nations.

Iranian interior minister Eskandar Momeni's visit to Pakistan, a key mediator in the conflict, pointed to intensified diplomatic efforts, but it was unclear what new arrangement might be reached to end the war. Explosions were heard around the city of Shiraz in southern Iran, state media said. Konarak and Chababhar on the south-

hern coast, the city of Khorramabad and a civilian site outside the city of Abadan, both in the west, all came under attack, media reports said.

Later the IRNA news agency quoted an official in Khorramabad as saying no enemy attack had taken place there. Fifty civilians have been killed and 500 wounded in the recent US strikes on Iran, a health ministry official said.

The US State Department said in a new warning to Americans that "Iran and groups supportive of Iran may target other US interests overseas or at locations associated with the United States and Americans throughout the world."

Momeni met Pakistan's army chief Field Marshal Asim Munir, according to two officials who spoke on the condition of anonymity. He later met Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif.

Pakistan's political leadership and Munir, who serves as both the chief of army staff and defense forces, played a key role in brokering last month's interim agreement between the United States and Iran. Islamabad has been working to persuade both sides to return to negotiating table to resolve outstanding issues under the June memorandum of understanding. **Agencies**

Risks from Hormuz, Red Sea have Oil Swinging

Brent oil swung after rallying more than 20% this month, as traders weighed threats to maritime traffic from the Strait of Hormuz and the Red Sea to a key Kazakh export terminal on Russia's coast.

The global benchmark traded around \$90 a barrel, fluctuating between small gains and losses. In a sign of continued Iranian attempts to strike tankers crossing Hormuz, another ship carrying oil products was hit.

Meanwhile, Yemen's Houthis threatened to block Saudi Arabia's maritime traffic in the Red Sea, adding another level of risk to supplies from the top OPEC producer. The Red Sea route has allowed the kingdom to export millions of barrels of crude via a cross-country pipeline that bypasses the Hormuz. Away from West Asia, there have also been disruptions at the Caspian Pipeline Consortium terminal on Russia's Black Sea coast, which ships most of Kazakhstan's oil. **-Bloomberg**
