After lion sightings & a fatal attack, state to hire forest 25 trackers for Mount Girnar

Ahmedabad, August 8

THE GUJARAT Forest Department will deploy 25 trackers exclusively for the Mount Girnar region to protect the pilgrims climbing through the stairways to the shrines above, after the fatal lion attack that killed a 12-year-old and lions were sighted along the route, both in July.

The authorities have received around 3,400 applications for the tracker posts on Mount Girnar, one of the most revered pilgrimage sites in Gujarat.

Nearly 10,000 steps lead to the peak of the mountain which has shrines important to Hindus and Jains that can be accessed by three stairways. Pilgrims usually climb through the night or early morning to reach the shrines through the Old Staircase, New Staircase and the Datar Staircase.

As recently as Thursday (August 6) night, three lions were spotted crossing the old and new staircases, Junagadh Deputy Conservator of Forests Akshay Joshi told *The Indian Express*.

Forest officials maintained continuous vigil on the big cats till they crossed into the forest and there was no human life conflict, DCF Joshi said in a statement. The Forest department authorities have also appealed to people to move only in groups in night time, not to leave their kids alone at all and to follow the instructions of the forest department.

The DCF Junagadh district, who is also a member of the Gujarat State Lion Conser-

vation Society (GSLCS), an arm of the state forest department, announced the new openings of forest trackers for the region last month with July 22 being the last date to apply. And around 3,400 candidates have applied for the post. The final appointments are expected to be done soon following completion of ongoing interviews and subsequent verifications.

To be appointed on an 11-month contract, each tracker has been offered a salary of Rs 15,914 per month. The candidates should be under 35 years old and should have cleared Class 10, apart from having a "keen interest in wildlife".

The Junagadh DCF said that apart from the minimum educational qualification, the aspiring candidates' fitness and knowledge about wildlife will be among the key areas to be considered in the recruitment process. On July 11, a 12-year-old boy who was climbing the mountain to visit the shrines with his family was dragged away by a lion, raising serious concerns

about the safety of the pilgrims.

Following the incident, Forest and Environment Minister Arjun Modhwadia had announced a range of measures to ensure security of pilgrims on Mount Girnar and the new hiring is a part of them.

Forest officials said that the forest trackers will be placed on duty at the area around Mount Girnar to see that the lions do not venture towards the stairs of the pilgrimage and even if they do they can be guided properly towards the forest.

Currently, a team of forest trackers from Sasan has been deployed in the region for the safety of pilgrims. From July 11, pride of lions have crossed the staircases of Mount Girnar, at least twice.

Forest trackers are considered a critical link in the lion conservation story of Gujarat. And currently, around 200-odd forest trackers are on job in the lion landscape of the state. The forest trackers provide real-time information on the movement of lion

prides in the region, alerting a human settlement if the big cat moves too close or trying to save the animal from being run over by a train.

Checkposts, AI cameras

Apart from recruitment of 25 forest trackers in the region around Girnar, the district forest authorities have submitted a proposal to the state government for the safety of pilgrims on Mount Girnar.

The proposal included setting up of nine permanent checkposts at different locations on the three staircases of Mount Girnar and installation of AI-enabled cameras in the areas near the pilgrims.

'A conspiracy hatched in jail': Amid fight for clout, Surat gangster killed

In a car with a woman friend, he was waylaid by bike-borne assailants: Police

A 32-YEAR-OLD gangster was murdered on Wednesday afternoon allegedly by his rival gang in front of his woman friend in Surat's Bhestan, an area in the textile and diamond hub dominated by migrants, police said.

The murder of Satish Dhagde alias Satish Maratha is suspected to be an outcome of gang rivalry to gain control of the area, police said, adding that nine persons, including three minors, were detained in connection with the murder.

The three minors were produced before the Juvenile Justice Board, which sent them to a remand home.

The remaining accused, identified as Ketan Sirsat (19), Rahul Dubey (20), Karan Dubey (20), Ajit Goswami (25), Akash Thakur (18) and Rahul Kapure (29), all residents of different areas in Surat, were produced before the Surat district court which remanded them in police custody till August 12.

The accused were arrested on the Sonagadh-Uchhal main road in Tapi district while fleeing on bikes towards Maharashtra, police said. Tapi neighbors Nandurbar district in Maharashtra.

According to police sources, the same gang had allegedly attacked Maratha a few days ago in Godavari area by sprinkling chilly powder in his

face. However, his associates saved him as the incident took place in the area where Maratha lived, sources said.

Police sources that a conspiracy for the murder was hatched in the city's central jail at Laipore by another gangster Rahul Mandal alias Rahul 'Apartment' to avenge an alleged assault on his gang member.

Maratha was in a car with a female friend when two bike-

borne youths signalled him to stop. One of them broke the driver side window pane and began to abuse Maratha. Sensing danger, Maratha asked his friend to escape and get out of the car to confront the rider, police said. "He was unaware that six to eight youths were by then on bikes at the scene," said police sources.

"He began running as the men armed with swords, knives and axes chased him. One of them allegedly fired two rounds from a pistol. The chase lasted around 50 metres after which the men got hold of Maratha and assaulted him with weapons. While defending himself from the blows of sharp weapons, his fingers were cut off. The accused inflicted repeated blows with sharp weapons even on his head, causing his death on the spot," said police. After seeing local people gathering at the spot, the accused escaped on their bikes.

The female friend called the police control room and officers from Bhestan police station reached the spot.

Maratha's brother Hitesh Dhagde lodged a complaint at Bhestan police station naming eight persons for allegedly murdering him.

The Dhagdes are originally from Dhule in Maharashtra. While Dhagde lives in Katargam, Maratha lived in Godavari and was involved in the real estate business.

Bloodshed after friends turned foes

Maratha allegedly had clout over Pandesara, Bhestan, Dindoli, Godadara, and Limbayat areas in Surat which have a dense migrant population.

Surat Assistant Commissioner of Police (J Division) SC Tarde said, "After primary investigations, we came to know that the conspiracy behind the murder of Satish Maratha was hatched in Surat Central Jail by another gangster, Rahul Mandal alias Rahul Apartment. Rahul and Satish were close friends, but they parted ways over various issues a few months ago, and this had led to the murder of Satish."

Sources said that after the break-up, Maratha and Mandal had a bitter rivalry to gain supremacy over the alleged bootlegging and gambling network in these areas. A police official said Mandal and Maratha along with one Hardik Patel were accused in the sensational murder of gangster Surya Marathi in his office at Ved Road, in February 2020.

Patel worked for Surya, but later fell out and allegedly hatched the conspiracy with the other two to kill him. However, during the assault,

Patel also died of injuries. Mandal, Maratha and others spent four years in prison in that case, but were acquitted in July last year.

'Society learns from them': State strongly opposes AAP MLA's plea against conviction

FIVE FOREST officials were allegedly made to stand in a line. Abusive words. A threat to their life. Then, according to the prosecution, a firearm was brought out and a shot was fired in the air. The State on Friday put a sharp question: what does such a conduct mean when the person accused of it is an elected MLA?

Opposing Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) MLA Chaitar Vasava (AAP) MLA Chaitar Vasava, who pleaded challenging his June 2026 conviction as well as seeking suspension of his seven-year jail sentence in the 2023 forest officials assault case, Public Prosecutor Mitesh Amin argued that an MLA occupies a position from which society expects others to learn how to speak, behave and treat people. Such a person, he submitted, "stands on a different footing". Vasava, the Dedipada MLA, was convicted by an Ad-

ditional Sessions Court at Rajpipla on June 23, along with eight co-accused, including his wife Shakuntala Vasava, and sentenced to seven years' rigorous imprisonment. The case arose from the October 30, 2023 confrontation involving forest officials after an encroachment removal drive in Bogal village. Amin submitted before Justice Vimal Vyas of the Gujarat High Court that the prosecution case began with forest officials being asked for several months to remove encroach-

ments from forest land. After a Forest Office Register was recorded on October 29, officials went to the site the following morning and removed crops from the encroached area.

The State's case is that the officials were subsequently summoned to Vasava's residence, where they were allegedly made to stand in a line and threatened to give compensation for the removed crop. The prosecution alleged that the confrontation escalated into abuse and threats to the officials' lives, followed by the alleged bringing of a firearm and firing of a round in the air.

Amin placed particular emphasis on the alleged firearm incident. According to his submission, Vasava instructed a person present at the spot to bring a firearm. "The firearm was brought," he said, before submitting that "a shot was fired in the air" to further

frighten the forest officials and endanger their lives.

No evidence for threat, use of firearm: MLA

Vasava has challenged both his conviction and sentence in the High Court and sought suspension of his seven-year punishment and bail during pendency of his appeal.

In his petition, Vasava has disputed the prosecution's account of the threats and firearm incident, contending that the allegations were unsupported by forensic or scientific evidence.

A TEAM of experts has found that the mysterious ripples and continuous waves in a newly constructed well in Gujarat's Morbi district were likely caused by groundwater recharge and trapped air pressure following heavy rainfall.

The State Water Data Centre team from Gandhinagar, which inspected the site on Friday, ruled out any seismic activity or geological disturbance as the cause of the unusual phenomenon that began on August 2.

An 18-foot-deep farm well in Virpada village in Morbi has been drawing large crowds because the water inside is continuously moving and creating wave-like ripples on its own.

Morbi Collector Swapnil Khare said "A ground investigation team from the State Water Data Centre in Gandhinagar visited the place on Friday. Their preliminary investigation suggests that groundwater recharge due to heavy rainfall may have triggered this phenomenon."

Nothing suspicious had been detected, he said.
