CSIR conclave reviews first-year progress of Phase III skill initiative

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) The Coordinators' Conclave-cum-Meeting of the Monitoring Committee of the CSIR Integrated Skill Initiative reviewed the progress made during the first year of Phase III of the initiative, an official statement said on Saturday. The statement from the Ministry of Science & Technology said the two-day meeting facilitated knowledge exchange among participating laboratories and strengthened collaboration for effective implementation of the programme. The conclave was hosted by CSIR-HRDC in association with CSIR-National Chemical Laboratory, Pune, and brought together Skill Nodal Coordinators from all 37 participating CSIR laboratories to present annual progress reports cover-

ing programmes conducted, trainee outreach, innovations, challenges and future action plans. These presentations enabled the Monitoring Committee to comprehensively assess the implementation status across laboratories while providing an excellent opportunity for sharing best practices and successful models of skill development. Dr. Mohana Krishna Reddy Mudiam, Director, Institute of Pesticide Formulation Technology (IPFT), Gurugram, and Chairman of the Monitoring Committee underscored that skill development is an integral part of nation-building and outlined five key priority pillars to guide the CSIR Integrated Skill Initiative towards building a robust, future-ready, and industry-aligned skill development ecosystem.

'AAERI Verify' on Digilocker to enable Indian students for paperless verification for Australia

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) A new digital platform, 'AAERI Verify', will enable Indian students to securely share their academic, identity and financial documents with Australian universities through DigiLocker, the government said on Saturday. 'AAERI Verify' is a source-verified authentication platform to streamline student credential checks for Australian higher education institutions, an official statement said, adding that students can securely share authentic, issuer-verified digital documents directly from trusted sources, reducing dependence on physical documents and manual verification processes. The National e-Governance Division (NeGD), under the Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology (MeitY), part-

nered with the Association of Australian Education Representatives in India (AAERI) to launch this new platform. Integrated directly with DigiLocker, this digital platform will enable secure, paperless, and consent-based verification for students applying to Australian universities. The platform was officially unveiled during the AAERI Annual Convention here, the statement from Ministry of Electronics and IT said. The newly-launched digital workflow replaces slow, manual document verification with a secure, consent-based verification in two stages: a Student Check and a Sponsor Check. The Student Check is conducted seamlessly before the university application process begins and the Sponsor Check is initiated

immediately after a student receives an admission offer to verify financial authenticity. "With the explicit consent of the student, DigiLocker will provide Australian universities direct access to digitally signed records from original issuing authorities. This eliminates the risk of fraud, ensures absolute data privacy, and cuts down application processing times drastically," the statement noted. J.L. Gupta, Director, NeGD gave a detailed presentation showcasing NeGD's foundational role in orchestrating India's Digital Public Infrastructure (DPI). NeGD operates as an independent business division established under MeitY, and supports macro project management, framing policies, and tech appraisals. The platform supports public

workflows across diverse statutory organizations. These include the Union Public Service Commission (UPSC), the Ministry of External Affairs (MEA), NITI Aayog etc. DigiLocker is a flagship DPI initiative under NeGD that provides citizens with a secure, consent-based wallet to store, share, and verify authentic digital documents issued directly by authorised organisations. DigiLocker currently serves over 72 crore registered users and enables secure issuance, storage, sharing and real-time verification of digitally signed documents issued by authorised institutions.—IANS

GI-tagged 'Mithila Makhana' exported to Australia for 1st time: Piyush Goyal

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) Commerce and Industry Minister Piyush Goyal on Saturday said that 18 metric tonnes of GI-tagged 'Mithila Makhana' was exported for the first time from Bihar to Australia via sea route. The consignment, procured directly from farmers in Darbhanga, has provided them with nearly 18 per cent more profit compared to the market price, Goyal posted on social media platform X. "India's GI-tagged Mithila Makhana has achieved another major milestone in the global market," said the minister. With the support of APEDA, 18 metric tonnes of GI-tagged Mithila Makhana was exported from Bihar to Australia. Last month, India achieved a major milestone in agricultural exports by dispatching its first sea-based shipment of Bihar's renowned Makhana (fox nuts) to Canada.

Indian stock markets post weekly gains as crude prices ease, Q1 earnings improve

Mumbai, Aug 8 (IANS) The Indian equity benchmarks posted gains for the second consecutive week, over sharp corrections in crude oil prices and strong Q1 FY27 earnings results. Nifty jumped 0.77 per cent during the week and shed 0.27 per cent on the last trading day this week to reach 24,570. At close, Sensex was down 455 points, or 0.58 per cent, at 78,499. It added 0.52 per cent during the week. Small-cap stocks continued to outperform, supported by strong earnings traction and stock-specific catalysts, while PSU banks led sectoral gains on improving fundamentals. Metals benefited from a stronger growth outlook and resilient domestic demand, while automobiles gained momentum on expectations of healthy festive-season demand, said market watchers.

The week started on a volatile note triggered by the rollout of the new F&O Closing Auction Session (CAS), but markets regained stability as participants adapted to the revised framework, an analyst said. "Sentiment improved meaningfully with the sharp decline in crude oil prices, which helped strengthen the macroeconomic outlook and supported expectations of easing inflationary pressures," he added. Globally, softer labour market indicators reduced the likelihood of a near-term Fed rate hike, leading to a moderation in US bond yields and a weaker dollar. On the domestic front, the RBI reinforced confidence by maintaining its policy stance, while modestly upgrading its growth outlook and lowering inflation projections.

Odisha secures Rs 43,437 crore investment proposals at 'Odisha Food Pro 2026'

Bhubaneswar, Aug 7 (IANS) The Odisha government on Friday signed 27 Memoranda of Understandings (MoUs) involving a proposed investment of Rs 41,748 crore and the potential to generate 35,252 jobs, signalling growing industry confidence in the state's food-processing ecosystem. The MoUs were signed at Food Pro 2026

in New Delhi, the first sector-focused investment roadshow organised outside Odisha. Expounding the vision behind the programme, Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi said, "The Food processing is not merely another industry. It is the bridge between our farmers' prosperity, rural transformation and Odisha's industrial future. Every investment in this sector creates value at the farm, generates employment in villages, strengthens exports and builds a stronger economy. Odisha is ready to become India's preferred destination

for food processing, and I invite industry to partner with us in this journey." The officials also claimed that more than an investment event, the initiative signalled Odisha's strategic shift towards developing integrated food processing ecosystems that connect agriculture with manufacturing, exports and global markets. In addition, the Odisha government also received 12 Investment Intent Forms (IIFs) involving a proposed investment of Rs 1,689 crore, with the potential to generate 8,064 employment opportunities.

Cumulatively, on the first day of the visit, the Odisha government secured total investment proposals worth Rs 43,437 crore, with the potential to create 43,316 employment opportunities, reflecting strong investor confidence in the state's rapidly emerging food processing ecosystem.

Addressing industry leaders, the Chief Minister said Odisha is no longer viewing food processing merely as an industrial sector but as a means of economic transformation benefiting farmers, fishermen, women entrepreneurs, Self-Help Groups, Farmer Produc-

er Organisations (FPOs) and rural enterprises. He added that the Odisha government aims to ensure that major agricultural and marine products are increasingly processed within the state, raising producers' incomes and creating sustainable jobs for youth. Highlighting Odisha's

FSSAI directs PIE Foods to halt sale of monk sweetener products

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) on Friday said that it issued a prohibition order directing PIE Foods to immediately stop the sale of its Monk Fruit Extract Sweetener and Monk Fruit Sweetener Drops after finding multiple violations of licensing and food safety regulations. According to the food regulator, an inspection found that the products were being marketed by PIE Foods without a valid relabeller endorsement in its FSSAI licence. Taking to the social media platform X, it noted that the company was operating an e-commerce website without the required e-commerce business endorsement in its licence. FSSAI said the product labels lacked mandatory declarations and carried claims such as '100 per cent Monk Fruit Extract' and 'Natural Ingredients'. In addition, the company's e-commerce platform displayed the claim 'Doctor Recommended', which the regulator said appeared to be in violation of the Food Safety and Standards (Labelling and Display) Regulations, 2020 and the Food Safety and Standards (Advertising and Claims) Regulations, 2018. In view of the violations, the regulator directed the company under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006 to immediately discontinue the sale of the two monk fruit sweetener products until it obtains a valid FSSAI Central Licence with the required endorsements. FSSAI also said the company must secure the necessary regulatory approval for the use of monk fruit extract which is treated as a non-specified food ingredient under the applicable provisions of the Food Safety and Standards Act, before resuming sales.

Govt asks Meta to curb deepfakes and harmful AI-generated content; examines how algorithms disseminate

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) The government has asked Meta to take corrective action against deepfakes and other harmful AI-generated content on its platforms, according to sources. They also indicated that the issue is whether a platform that actively decides what users see can maintain intermediary status under the Information Technology Act. The Centre is also looking into whether Meta still qualifies as an intermediary under Indian law given the role its recommendation systems play in determining what content users see. If the tech giant's recommendation systems determine 'what is shown to whom' and 'promote content for payment,' these functions raise the question of whether they are consistent with the legal definition of an intermediary, according to the sources. Moreover, if platform chooses what content is displayed to users that is equivalent to publishing, and platforms would then be held accountable. The matter becomes important since the Act grants intermediaries certain legal protections, provided they meet certain requirements. In addition, after several rounds of talks over the past few days, the government has also requested that Meta take action against deepfakes. Therefore, in order to obtain an exemption from liability with regard to third-party information uploaded, published, hosted, shared or transmitted on or through their platform, intermediaries -- including social media platforms -- are legally required by section 79 of the IT Act, read in conjunction with IT Rules, 2021 to exercise due diligence.

Need for stronger governance, professional management of new urban co-operative banks

New Delhi, Aug 8 (IANS) The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to resume licensing of urban co-operative banks (UCBs) on 'on tap' basis but there is a need for stronger governance, professional management, timely oversight, and secure technology adoption for resilience, according to a new report. There are around 1,457 UCBs in India as of March 2025, which hold nearly 2 per cent of the deposits. Licensing of new UCBs has been paused since 2004, so, this step will enhance financial inclusion, but there is a need for stronger governance and professional management, said SBI Research in its report. UCBs have long been an essential part of India's cooperative story, providing banking services to segments - often underserved by larger banks - small traders, self-employed individuals, salaried workers, and others in the informal sector. The Central Bank is also issuing directions after a comprehensive review of the credit monitoring arrangement for rural cooperative banks (RCB), considering experience gained and developments since the framework was last revised in 2008. Share of RCB in total assets of cooperative sector has increased from 66.9 per cent in March 2020 to 71.2 per cent in March 2024. However, given the narrow business base on the lending side, RCB continue to face the challenges of lending portfolio concentration (sector and geographic) compared to UCBs. The current measure addresses this aspect of the RCB structure, the report mentioned.

FII's remain net buyers in India for 2nd consecutive week

Mumbai, Aug 8 (IANS) Foreign institutional investors (FIIs) remained net buyers in India for the second consecutive week, following net purchases of Rs 5,949 crore in the previous week, with an additional Rs 2,911 crore in the current week, based on provisional exchange data. On the other hand, domestic institutional investors (DIIs) also maintained their buying momentum, recording net purchases of Rs 7,768 crore, with inflows observed in four of the five trading sessions. "The sustained buying by both FIIs and DIIs was largely driven by the de-escalation of geopolitical tensions, which helped strengthen investor confidence and supported positive market sentiment," said Pabitra Mukherjee, Deputy Vice President-Research, Bajaj Broking. In July, FIIs were net buyers to the tune of \$2.5 billion while Nifty rose 2.2 per cent (month-on-month) after a 1.4 per cent rise in June. FIIs turned net buyers in July after being net sellers for four consecutive months since March. The primary market recorded net FII inflows of Rs 123 billion and the secondary market saw net FII inflows of Rs 110 billion. FII ownership as a percentage of total Indian equities has fallen from 20 per cent in July 2016 to 14.3 per cent in July 2026, according to a latest note by JM Financial Institutional Securities. DII ownership as a percentage of total Indian equities has risen over the years, reaching 18.7 per cent in March 2026.
