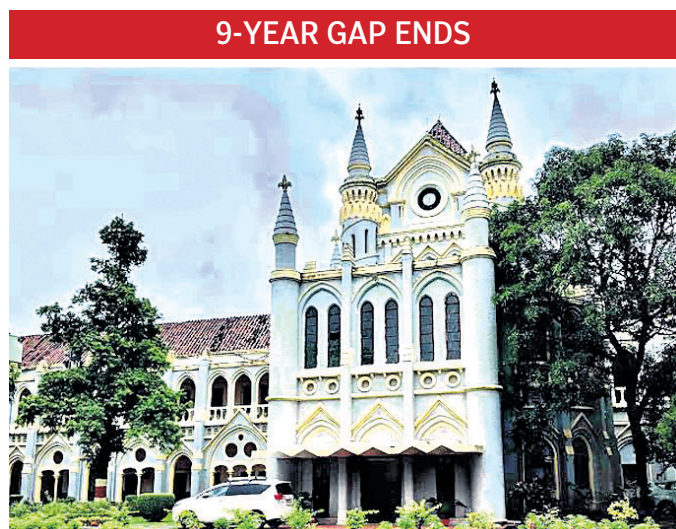

Jabalpur, August 4: The path for student union elections in Madhya Pradesh has been cleared after nine years, with the government submitting the academic calendar to the MP High Court, stating that polls have been scheduled in September across all universities and colleges.

A bench of acting Chief Justice Vivek Rushia and Justice Pradeep Mittal took the information presented by the Higher Education Department on record Monday, and dismissed a PIL stating that fees are being charged from students in the name of student union elections but polls are not held.

The process of forming student unions in government higher education institutions in the state has been stalled since 2017, impacting the dem-



ocratic representation of students, said the Public Interest Litigation (PIL) filed by student leader Adnan Ansari.

The government is not effectively implementing the recommendations of the Lyngdoh Committee, it claimed.

Hearing the petition earlier in January, the high court had directed the submission of the academic calendar for conducting the student body polls for 2026-27.

Last month, the government sought more time to file the plan, which it eventually submitted Monday.

Passport verification process simplified in Gujarat

Ahmedabad, August 4: The Gujarat Police Tuesday simplified the passport verification process in the state, as part of which the applicants will no longer be required to visit police stations, with the exercise now limited to checking citizenship and criminal antecedents.

Gujarat Director General of Police G S Malik issued directions to this effect.

The directions aim to make the passport verification process more transparent and citizen-friendly while reducing unnecessary inconvenience, the state government said in a release Tuesday.

As per the revised procedure, passport applicants will no longer be required to appear in person at police stations for verification.

During the police verification process, officers will only verify the applicant's citizenship and criminal history.

The police have also been instructed not to carry out separate verification of the applicant's residential address. Officers will not be required to meet applicants in person or obtain their signatures as part of the verification process.

According to the release, police personnel may visit an applicant's residence only in exceptional cases where they find something suspicious or require further verification. Even in such cases, applicants should not be summoned to the police station.

CATERER MOVES COPS OVER RECOVERY OF 'DUES'

Indore, August 4: Nearly 15 months after the marriage of local businessman Raja Raghuvanshi, who was killed during his honeymoon in Meghalaya, the wedding caterer Tuesday approached the police here to seek their help in the recovery of alleged outstanding payment of ₹2.82 lakh, an official said.

The caterer said he had contacted both the families several times over his dues, but the two sides blamed each other over the issue. The police, however, declined to take action on the complaint, stating that the civil dispute between the two parties did not merit police intervention.

Raja Raghuvanshi and his wife, Sonam Raghuvanshi, had gone to Meghalaya for their honeymoon in May 2025, a few days after their wedding, where Raja was murdered. The Meghalaya Police had arrested Sonam, her alleged lover, Raj Kushwaha, and three hired killers, in connection with the murder.

Indore-based caterer Hitesh Rohira told PTI that Raja and Sonam's families had jointly awarded him a contract for

catering at the wedding, amounting to ₹11,42,550. He claimed that he received ₹8,60,000 of this amount, while ₹282,550 are yet to be paid. Rohira said he had contacted Raja's elder brother, Vipin Raghuvanshi, and Sonam's elder brother, Govind Raghuvanshi, several times regarding the outstanding amount, but both were blaming each other for the non-payment. He said he had also sent a legal notice to Vipin and Govind through his lawyer on April 1, but he has failed to get the outstanding amount.

The caterer said he went to the Dwarkapuri police station to file a complaint against Vipin and Govind, but his case was not registered.

When asked about this, Dwarkapuri police station in-charge Manish Mishra said that the dispute over money transactions between the two parties does not merit police intervention as it is a civil case.

Meanwhile, Raja's brother Vipin Raghuvanshi said, "The caterer was booked by Sonam's

elder brother Govind. Our family has no outstanding transactions with the caterer."

Sonam's brother Govind Raghuvanshi claimed that almost all the amount of the caterer has been settled. "Where was the caterer all this time? Nearly 15 months after the wedding, he is claiming pending payment just to get cheap publicity," Govind said.

Raja and Sonam had gone missing during their honeymoon in Meghalaya last year. Raja's body was later recovered from a deep gorge near a waterfall in the Sohra (Cherrapunji) area of East Khasi Hills district.

Sonam was arrested from Ghazipur in Uttar Pradesh June 9, 2025, for allegedly conspiring with her alleged lover Raj Kushwaha and three hired killers to murder her husband. She spent more than 10 months in judicial custody in Shillong before being released on bail. The Supreme Court set aside the bail granted to Sonam and directed her to surrender within three weeks before police July 23.

Gandhinagar, August 4: On high alert following heavy downpours last week, the Gujarat health department has organised 6,868 medical camps,

Action Plan was implemented across all 34 districts and 8 Municipal Corporations before and during the monsoon.

"As a result, despite widespread flooding and heavy rainfall, no major public health emergency has been reported, and disease outbreaks have remained largely under control," the release noted.

The health department has been conducting regular health check-ups for people staying in relief camps set up in rain-hit areas, it said.

As many as 675 pregnant women from flood-affected areas were shifted to healthcare facilities in advance, where 272 deliveries were successfully conducted, the government said.

Round-the-clock health control rooms were set up in all 34 districts and across eight municipal corporations, it stated, adding that each district was provided five additional emergency medical teams, along with dedicated vehicles and staff.

To ensure a quick emergency response, 1,496 ambulances under the 108 Emergency Service and 816 primary health and community health centre ambulances have been kept on standby, the release said.

Gujarat health dept ramps up surveillance

Ahmedabad, August 4: The Gujarat government's health department has stepped up surveillance and rapid response measures to prevent any further fatality due to Chandipura virus, which has claimed the lives of 22 children during the ongoing monsoon season, officials said Tuesday.

Of 184 suspected infection cases reported in the state during the season, 35 persons have tested positive and 22 of them have died, Health Minister Praful Panseriya has said earlier.

These 22 deceased children were below 15 years of age, including babies, according to him. State Health Department's Additional Chief Secretary, Rajeev Topno, said, "Since no anti-dote has been developed yet for the Chandipura virus, we have ramped up surveillance and rapid response measures, and geared up health services to minimise deaths as much as possible. Our entire system is fully mobilised."

Dr Mehul Gosai, Head of the Pediatric Department of Sir T Hospital, a government hospital at Bhavnagar, said that patients suspected of Chandipura virus exhibited symptoms such as high fever, headache, and seizure and remain in a semi-conscious state. "On July 28, a nine-month-old infant was admitted to Sir T Hospital following a positive report from the Gandhinagar GBRC lab. The infant received intensive care in the pediatric department and

was successfully treated and discharged," he said. Out of 13 suspected cases that have been admitted in the hospital, three turned positive for the virus, one of whom died, he said. As per the government directive, all the samples of suspected Chandipura virus cases are being sent to Gandhinagar-based Gujarat Biotechnology Research Centre (GBRC) for lab examination. Medical Superintendent In-charge of Bhavnagar-based Sir T Hospital, Dr Kervi Desai, said that reports of samples sent to the lab are received within two days.

BJP forms 2-member panel to review loss

Bhopal: The BJP Tuesday constituted a two-member committee to review the reasons behind its defeat in the Datia assembly bypoll in Madhya Pradesh, a day after the Congress retained the seat, amid claims of sabotage by the ruling party candidate. Chief Minister Mohan Yadav held a meeting with senior party leaders at his residence during the day, following which a panel was formed. The BJP, in a statement, said that the party's state general secretary Gaurav Randive and senior leader Ambaram Karada have been appointed as members of the committee. The panel will discuss with responsible officials and senior leaders involved in the election, analyse the reasons for the defeat, and submit a report of its findings to state president Hemant Khandelwal. The Congress Monday retained the Datia assembly seat, with Ghanshyam Singh trouncing BJP's Ashutosh Tiwari by 6,016 votes. Singh polled 66,757 votes, while Tiwari received 60,741. Azad Samaj Party candidate Damodar Yadav received 22,527 votes, finishing third.

Congress writes to Gujarat CM

Cong says over 9 lakh Gujarat students awaiting scholarships under central scheme

Ahmedabad, August 4: The Congress Tuesday claimed more than 9 lakh students in Gujarat belonging to Other Backward Classes (OBC), Economically Backward Classes (EBC) and Denotified Tribes (DNT) have not received scholarships under a central government scheme for over six months now.

The main Opposition party urged the BJP government to release the pending funds immediately under the PM-YASASVI scheme.

PM Young Achievers Scholarship Award Scheme for Vibrant India (PM-YASASVI) is a comprehensive umbrella scheme which provides financial aid for school and college education to students from OBC, EBC, and DNT communities. Talking to reporters here, Gujarat Congress spokesperson Manish Doshi said the delay in disbursement of scholarships has put students and their parents under financial stress, with many making repeated visits to schools, colleges and government offices with-



out getting any clarity on when the funds will be released.

Doshi informed that he has written to Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel, urging the state government to immediately release the pending scholarship amounts to eligible students. According to him, around 4.25 lakh students eligible for the PM YASASVI Pre-Matric Scholarship and nearly five lakh students eligible for the Post-Matric Scholarship in Gujarat have not received their dues for more than six months. "The scholarship amounts have remained pending because the state government has

not received grants from the Centre and due to technical glitches in the online scholarship system and the National Scholarship Portal," Doshi alleged.

He claimed that despite repeated visits by students and parents to educational institutions and government offices, they have not received any satisfactory response regarding the delay in fund disbursement. The state Congress spokesperson alleged several other welfare benefits meant for students from economically weaker sections have also been affected due to shortage of funds.

"Benefits such as uniforms, bicycles and hostel food bills have also remained pending due to non-receipt of grants. As a result, students from poor families are facing financial difficulties and their education is being adversely affected," he claimed.

Doshi said the PM-YASASVI scheme, implemented by the Union Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, is meant to support students from socially and economically disadvantaged communities so they can continue their education. He urged the state government to ensure that eligible students receive their scholarships without any further delay.

In his letter to the chief minister, Doshi demanded that the Pre-Matric and Post-Matric scholarships be released immediately in accordance with the scheme guidelines for eligible students belonging to OBC, EBC and Denotified Tribes.

He called upon the BJP government to take urgent steps to resolve the problems being faced by students and their families due to the delay in scholarship payments.
