FOOD SAFETY: 124 kg paneer, 44 kg ghee seized from house

The Food Safety Administration seized around 124 kilograms of paneer and 44 kilograms of ghee from a house in Vinoba Nagar during a surprise inspection on Friday. The total seized food

products, weighing about 168 kilograms, are estimated to be worth Rs 65,000.

The action was carried out by a joint team of food safety officers at the residence of Ankit Mehwada near Patrakar Chauraha. The department had received information that Mehwada, a

resident of Rasulpura village in Sehore district, was bringing low-quality paneer and ghee from outside and supplying them in Indore.

During the inspection, officials found 124 kilograms of paneer and 44 kilograms of ghee stored in a freezer at the house. Mehwada re-

portedly told the officials that he sold the products at different places in Indore.

Suspecting that the products did not meet the required quality standards, the team collected one sample each of paneer and ghee for laboratory testing. The remaining 168 kg of

food products were seized until the test reports are received.

The samples will be sent to a food testing laboratory. Further action will be taken under the Food Safety and Standards Act, 2006, if the products are found to be substandard.

Department of Posts campaign

Win up to Rs 50k by writing to Mother Earth

Indore residents have an opportunity to put their thoughts on nature conservation into words and compete for prizes of up to Rs 50,000 under the Department of Posts' 'Dhai Akhar Letter Writing Campaign 2026-27'. This year's theme is 'A Letter to Mother Earth: My Promise to Protect Nature.'

Citizens of all age groups can participate. Entries can be submitted to the Superintendent of Post Offices, Indore City Division, either through Speed Post or personally.

The last date to submit entries is Oct 31. Participants will be divided into two age groups: up to 18

years and above 18 years. Each age group will have two categories: inland letter and envelope. Inland letters can contain up to 500 words, while letters written on envelopes can have a maximum of 1,000 words. Letters must be handwritten in Hindi, English or a local language. Participants will also have to attach a self-attested age declaration stating their age as on Jan 1.

The top three entries in each sub-category at the Madhya Pradesh Circle level will receive Rs 25,000, Rs 10,000 and Rs 5,000. Selected entries will proceed to the national competition, where the top prize is Rs 50,000. State-level results will be announced on Dec 15.

Philately scholarships for students

Students of Classes 6 to 9 interested in philately can apply for the Deen Dayal SPARSH Scholarship Scheme 2026-27 till Sept 22. The Department of Posts will award a scholarship of Rs 6,000 for one year to selected students.

Ten students from each class will be selected in the city. Applicants must have secured at least 60% marks or an equivalent grade in their previous examination. Students belonging to the SC and ST categories will get a five-percentage-point relaxation. Students who are members of a

philately club in their school are eligible. Those studying in schools without a philately club can apply if they have an active philately deposit account at any post office.

The selection will be conducted in two stages. A written multiple-choice quiz will be held on Sept 30, covering current affairs, history, geography, science, sports and culture, besides local and national philately. Students shortlisted in the quiz will have to submit a philately project by Nov 5. Applications must reach the office of the superintendent of post offices of Indore, through Speed Post by 4 pm on Sept 22.

Teachers climb school rooftop for mobile signal to mark e-attendance

Teachers in rural areas are reportedly facing a peculiar challenge while complying with the state government's mandatory digital attendance system. They climbing on school rooftops to find mobile network signals.

The incident was reported at Tatan Jan Shiksha Kendra in Chhatrapur, where a video reportedly shows teachers standing on the school roof with their mobile phones in an attempt to get a network signal and mark their attendance.

Teachers have com-

plained that poor mobile connectivity in rural areas has made the e-attendance system a major challenge. Similar complaints have reportedly emerged from several parts of MP after the Directorate of Public Instruction (DPI) made e-attendance mandatory for teachers and other school employees through Humare Shikshak mobile application.

The problem was compounded on Thursday when teachers across the state reportedly faced technical issues while trying to mark their logat attendance through the app.

IDA to spend Rs 61cr on commercial markets across city

The Indore Development Authority (IDA) has approved a plan to spend nearly Rs 61 crore on developing commercial markets and related facilities on several major plots across the city. Tenders for the projects are expected to be issued shortly, while five other large plots will be developed under the Public-Private Partnership (PPP) model. According to the plan, commercial facilities will be developed on plots in Schemes 78, 94 and 134, among others. The projects include local shopping complexes and commercial spaces intended to improve the availability of organised facilities for residents.

Two workers die in separate incidents; contractor, house owner among those booked

Two construction workers died of electrocution in separate incidents in the city, with police registering cases for negligence against those responsible for safety at the sites.

In the first incident, Aerodrome police registered a case for negligence following the death of 20-year-old Karan Bhal, a resident of Khargone district. The incident occurred on July 5 when Karan was working at a residential construction site in Shiram Nagar, Chhoti Bangar Road.

According to witnesses, while moving a concrete mixer machine, workers suffered electric shocks due to an improperly installed cable, with Karan sustaining severe injuries. He was rushed to MY Hospital, where doctors declared him dead.

Witnesses alleged that contractor Pankaj Bhartiya of Scheme No. 71, Dwarkapuri, failed to ensure electrical safety or provide basic protective gear, including gloves and safety boots, leading to Karan's death. Police investigation is ongoing. In the second incident, Rajendra Nagar police registered a case against contractor Dinesh

Child deaths snowball into major controversy

Cong MLA claims 19 child deaths; health dept admits eight

Child deaths due to an outbreak of seasonal diseases have snowballed into a major controversy in Balaghat district. The health department has sought a detailed ground report from block medical officers (BMOs) on child deaths following an outbreak of an unidentified seasonal illness and hospitalisation of 128 children in the remote, Tribal-dominated Baiga villages of Balaghat district.

On Friday, collector Kumar Satyam with the health department team visited villages and took stock of the health condition of children who are undergoing treatment. According to the health department, 128 children were hospitalised in serious condition and 97 of them have been discharged after recovering following treatment and 31 remain under treatment.

Additionally, 2,100 people have been screened so far, with 530 exhibiting symptoms of various ill-nesses during the

examination. Of these, 97 were treated in hospitals and 402 recovered after receiving treatment at home.

Villages in the Tribal-dominated area, specifically Machhura, Adori, Gathiya, Boudhri, Korika, Kohnim, and Kundekha, have been affected. There is an outbreak of malaria, typhoid, diarrhoea and skin diseases among children in these villages.

However, the health department and local Congress MLA are in a face-off over child deaths. Cong-Member of Assembly (Bairhar) Sanjay Uke has claimed that 19 children died in his Vidhan Sabha constituency. He also released the list of the deceased.

Health dept seeks report

CMHO Dr Paresh Uplav informed Free Press: "We have sought report of 19 kids deaths from BMO. However, so far eight children have died in Balaghat due to seasonal disease like Malaria, dehydration, typhoid. Besides, some children developed fungal infection. Out of eight, seven children who died, were not brought to hospital. Only one girl of three year was brought to hospital, died as she was severely malnourished and under weight."

हनी ट्रैप' की चर्चा: भद्र समाज वॉट्सऐप ग्रुप में वायरल मैसेज से मचा हड़कंप

पांच पुरुषों पर आरोपों के बीच 'पांच पेटी में सेटलमेंट' और बीचबान से समझौते की ?

मह। जानकारी अनुसार नगर में भद्र समाज के वॉट्सऐप ग्रुप में वावरल हुए मैसेजे ने सामाजिक हलकों में हलचल मचा दी है। वावरल मैसेज में एक महिला पांच पुरुषों पर गंभीर आरोप का दावा किया जा रहा है।

सूत्रों के अनुसार वावरल मैसैज में आरोप-प्रत्यारोप के बीच लोकेश टाइल्स से 'पांच पेटी में सेटलमेंट' होने का बात कही गई है। वहीं अन्य मामलों में बीचवान के माध्यम से समझौते की राह निकालने की चर्चा है। मैसैज में 'महालक्ष्मी की कृपा' जैसे शब्दों का इस्तेमाल होने से मामला और तुल पकड़ रहा है।

बताया जा रहा है कि इस मैसेज के वायरल होने के बाद समाज के कई समूहों में चचाओं का दौर गर्म है। लोग इसे 'सामाजिक हनी ट्रैप' से जोड़कर देख रहे हैं। हालांकि मैसेज की सत्यता और आरोपों की पुष्टि नहीं हो सकी है।

स्थानीय स्तर पर चर्चा है कि ऐसे मामलों में अक्सर रोप, फिर बीचबान और बाद में आर्थिक लेनदेन कर मझौते का पैटर्न सामने आता है। पुलिस तक मामला पहुँचने से पहले ही 'सेटलमेंट' हो जाने से असलियत दब जाती है।

फिलहाल इस वायरल मैसेज को लेकर कोई औपचारिक शिकायत दर्ज होने की जानकारी सामने नहीं है। सामाजिक संगठनों में इस प्रवृत्ति को लेकर चिंता ताई जा रही है।
