Signal stays strong for Bharti Airtel

Rising Arpu, expected tariff hikes to dial up next leg of growth

Mumbai, 6 August

Bharti Airtel’s first-quarter (April-June/Q1) performance for 2026-27 (FY27) beat estimates on most parameters, aided by a strong performance in both its India and Africa businesses. Topline growth was driven by a sharp increase in average revenue per user (Arpu) as well as robust subscriber additions.

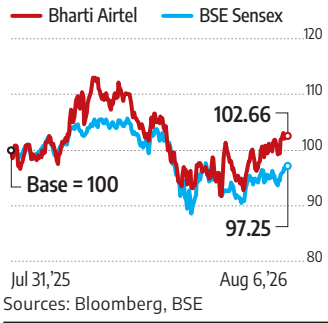
While tariff hikes remain the key trigger for the sector and Airtel, the company is looking to increase Arpu within its existing customer base until the hikes — expected in the second half of FY27 — materialise. While most brokerages are positive on the company’s outlook, some believe the gains are already reflected in valuations. At the current price, the telecommunications major is trading at 9x enterprise value to operating profit. The stock has delivered little over the past year and is only marginally in the green.

At the consolidated level, the company reported revenue growth of 18.4 per cent year-on-year (Y-o-Y) and 5.7 per cent sequentially. Operating profit rose 19.6 per cent Y-o-Y and 5.8 per cent quarter-on-quarter (Q-o-Q). The strong sequential growth was largely driven by the Africa business, which posted a 9.6 per cent increase, while other businesses recorded growth in the 3-4 per cent range. Consolidated operating profit margin expanded by 3 basis points (bps) to 56.9 per cent, led by a 14-bp expansion in the India wireless business.

Revenue from the India business rose 3.6 per cent sequentially, with the outperformance driven by a strong Arpu of ₹263.9, up 2.6 per cent from the fourth quarter (January-March/Q4) of 2025-26 (FY26). The gains were supported by post-paid additions and a richer 5G subscriber mix. Overall subscriber additions stood at 3.3 million compared with 4.7 million in the previous quarter, but remained higher

than the FY26 average of 2.9 million. This expanded the subscriber base to 376.5 million.

Postpaid net additions of 1 million in the India mobile business marked the strongest quarterly performance in more than 13 quarters. HSBC Research remains constructive on Airtel’s structural growth drivers and expects mobile Arpu to rise, led by a tariff hike in Q1 of calendar year 2027, subscriber migration to higher data plan buckets driven by increased data usage, and continued gains in high-value post-paid subscribers. Analysts led by Piyush Choudhary forecast mobile Arpu to reach ₹310 by 2027-28. The brokerage has a “buy” rating with a target price of ₹2,500.

In the Africa business, the company reported an overall subscriber base of 189 million, up 11.6 per cent Y-o-Y. Africa added 5.5 million subscribers during the quarter compared with the FY26 average of 4.4 million. Aided by a 16 per cent Y-o-

Y increase in Arpu to \$2.7 per month, revenue grew 45.6 per cent, while operating profit increased 52 per cent Y-o-Y.

JM Financial Research has marginally raised its FY27 to 2028-29 (FY29) operating profit estimates by 1-2 per cent, factoring in strong growth in the Africa business. The brokerage has reiterated its “buy” rating, as it expects the industry’s wireless Arpu to grow at 12 per cent annually over FY26-FY29, driven by regular tariff hikes and multiple premiumisation strategies. Analysts led by Dayanand Mittal say visibility has improved for a tariff hike of around 15 per cent over the next six to 12 months, given that the last increase was in July 2024. They also cite the government’s intent to ensure a “3+1” player market and the industry’s need to improve return on capital employed amid its inability to adequately monetise the significant investments made in 5G. The brokerage has a “buy” rating with a target price of ₹2,400.

The home business continued to deliver robust revenue growth of 33 per cent Y-o-Y, supported by strong subscriber additions, although margins in both the home and digital television segments remained weak. Morgan Stanley Research has an “overweight” rating on the stock with a target price of ₹2,480. According to analysts led by Gaurav Rateria, upside risks include higher-than-expected market share gains, steeper-than-expected tariff hikes, and monetisation opportunities from the company’s assets.



GOLD LOAN REPAYMENT OPTIONS

Choose based on cash flow, not loan amount eligibility

The Reserve Bank of India’s (RBI’s) revised loan-to-value (LTV) ratio norms, effective April 1, 2026, will reduce disbursements under bullet repayment gold loans. Lenders must calculate LTV on total repayment, including accrued interest, rather than principal alone. The maximum tenure of bullet loans has also been capped at 12 months. A recent Icr report says lenders could shift their portfolios towards regularly serviced loans.

Lower eligibility

The reduction in the sanctioned amount will depend on loan size, interest rate and tenure. “These norms are expected to reduce upfront disbursal under bullet repayment plans by around 10 to 15 per cent,” says Abhishek Kumar, Securities and Exchange Board of India (Sebi)-registered investment adviser and founder, SahajMoney.com.

Bullet loans offer flexibility

The bullet repayment option remains appealing despite lower disbursals. “It provides immediate liquidity without the burden of monthly repayments,” says Umesh Mohanan, executive

director (ED) and chief executive officer (CEO), Indel Money.

Borrowers must, however, repay the entire principal and accumulated interest at maturity. “The large lump sum obligation at maturity increases the risk of default,” says Kumar. Borrowers must also settle their entire interest obligation before they can roll over the loan.

Regular servicing eases repayment

Under an EMI structure, the outstanding principal declines over time. “A borrower pays less interest over the tenure than under a comparable bullet repayment structure and avoids the large repayment obligation at maturity,” says Adhil Shetty, CEO, BankBazaar. The 12-month cap earned tenure does not apply to regularly serviced loans.

Compare total borrowing cost

Bullet repayment typically costs the most. “As there is no reduction in the monthly principal, the total interest outgo is generally higher than under a regular gold loan repayment,” says Santosh Agarwal, CEO, Paisabazaar.

Monthly interest-only repayment (principal repayed at the end) is more cost-effective than

bullet repayment. “Regular interest payments prevent accumulation and compounding,” says Jyoti Prakash Gadia, managing director, Resurgent India.

EMIs are the most cost-efficient because each instalment reduces the principal. “Borrowers should, however, compare the interest rate, total borrowing cost, processing and valuation charges, renewal conditions, delayed-payment penalties and auction policy before selecting a loan,” says Agarwal.

Match repayment to cash flow

Cash flow, not maximum eligibility, should determine the choice of repayment option. “Those with a regular monthly income will find EMIs more manageable. Those expecting a defined lump sum inflow may find bullet repayment suitable. Borrowers with seasonal or periodic income may find quarterly repayments more attractive,” says Shetty. Loan tenure also matters. “The 12-month maturity limit restricts

bullet repayment to short-duration loans,” says Gadia. Borrowers seeking a longer tenure should avoid it.

Manage gold-price risk

Gold prices in India have corrected by 2.4 per cent over the past six months. Under bullet repayment, the principal remains outstanding and unpaid interest raises the liability, making the LTV ratio more vulnerable to a sharp fall in gold prices. The lender may seek additional cash or gold, or partial repayment. Since interest consumes some collateral value upfront, borrowers under the bullet repayment option have a smaller buffer against falling gold prices.

EMI-based loans reduce the outstanding principal each month and therefore lower the risk of margin calls over time. Regular interest servicing option also keeps the liability constant instead of allowing it to rise. “A borrower expecting volatile gold prices or having limited capacity to arrange emergency funds should prefer regular EMI or interest servicing,” says Harsh Virra, chief financial planner and founder, FinPro Wealth.

Choose the right option

Bullet repayment suits borrowers expecting a lump-sum inflow within a year. “It is suitable for traders, farmers and self-employed individuals,” says Mohanan. Monthly interest servicing suits freelancers and small businesses seeking flexible working capital. EMIs suit salaried borrowers and others with stable monthly cash flows. “Prioritise affordability and repayment certainty over the lowest immediate monthly outflow,” says Virra.
