West must take India more seriously in role to balance China: Report

New Delhi, July 31 (IANS) While for the last 20 years, Western governments have seen India as indispensable to the 21st-century order, they have not matched this with capital investment which has instead been flowing into China over the last 30 years and created a strategic adversary, according to an article published by Lowy Institute, an Australian think tank. The article highlights that India is not yet the anchor of an industrial alternative capable of balancing China. But it is the only country with the scale to become one. The West is now trying to correct a compounded strategic error by relying

on incremental corporate decisions. Companies are encouraged to adopt "China plus one", but they face incentives that favour China which has better infrastructure such as power and ports, that rising industrial powers are still trying to build, the article written by Stephanie Campbell states. "The policy failure is to mistake the accumulation of fragmented corporate decisions for strategic rebalancing. Governments now ask firms to bear the cost of reversing a concentration created by decades of collective investment and reinforced by Western policy," the article observes.

Protest held outside Pak Embassy in Washington

Washington, July 31 (IANS) A demonstration was held outside the Embassy of Pakistan in Washington over the worsening humanitarian situation in Pakistan-occupied Kashmir (PoK), with protesters raising concerns over reports of deaths, injuries and alleged use of force during ongoing unrest in the region. According to posts shared on social media, demonstrators gathered outside the Pakistani Embassy to highlight concerns over the situation and call for accountability as reports of casualties continued to increase. The protest came amid escalating tensions in PoK, where clashes between protesters and security forces have reportedly resulted in multiple deaths and injuries. Reports have cited allegations of security forces using live ammunition during demonstrations.

China hacked US voter data, says White House

Washington, July 31 (IANS) The White House released a fact sheet asserting that declassified US intelligence documents show the People's Republic of China and its proxies obtained the voter registration data of as many as 220 million Americans, including information that was not publicly available. The fact sheet was issued by the White House Government Transparency Task Force and said it had been approved by the directors of the Office of the Director of National Intelligence, the National Security Agency, the Central Intelligence Agency and the Department of Homeland Security. It relates to President Donald Trump's recent declassification of intelligence documents concerning foreign election activities. According to the fact sheet, "The People's Republic of China (China) and their proxies bought, stole, or hacked as many as 220 million Americans' voter registration data. China's collection included non-publicly available data." The White House also released what it described

as the Intelligence Community's official definition of "election interference", saying the newly declassified documents distinguish it from the broader category of election influence. According to the released definition: "Election influence includes overt and covert influence activities of foreign governments or actors serving as agents of, or on behalf of, foreign governments intended to affect directly or indirectly a US election- including candidates, political parties, voters or their preferences, or political processes. Election interference is a subset of election influence targeted at the technical aspects of the election, including voter registration, casting and counting of ballots, and reporting of results." The administration said the definition explicitly includes efforts by a foreign power targeting voter registration infrastructure or voter registration data. The fact sheet further stated that Intelligence Community documents from 2022 identified a Chinese Computer Network Exploitation (CNE) actor as having acquired voter registration data stored on commercial websites.

Thermax shares tumble over 16 pc after Q1 profit slumps 83 pc on project cost escalation

Mumbai, July 31 (IANS) Shares of Thermax Limited came under intense selling pressure on Friday after the company reported a steep decline in earnings for the June quarter, with investors reacting sharply to the weak profitability and a significant cost overrun in one of its projects. The stock fell as much as 16.08 per cent during intra-day trade to Rs 3,566.90 on the Bombay Stock Exchange (BSE). During noon trade, the shares were trading near the day's low at Rs 3,680, down 13.43 per cent. The sharp fall in the stock followed the company's June-quarter results, which showed consolidated net profit plunging 83.4 per cent year-on-year to Rs 25.2 crore from Rs 152.4 crore in the corresponding period last financial year. Despite the steep decline in profit, Thermax reported a 6.7 per cent increase in revenue from operations, which rose to Rs 2,303 crore during the quarter from Rs 2,158 crore a year earlier. The company's operating performance also

weakened significantly. Earnings before interest, tax, depreciation and amortisation (EBITDA) dropped 69.5 per cent year-on-year to Rs 68.6 crore from Rs 225 crore in the year-ago quarter. Consequently, the EBITDA margin narrowed sharply to 3 per cent from 10.4 per cent. Thermax attributed the weak quarterly performance primarily to a Rs 91 crore increase in the estimated cost required to complete a specific project in its Industrial Infrastructure segment after certain developments were identified during the quarter. The company also

noted that the corresponding quarter of the previous financial year had benefited from Rs 56 crore of income received under the Package Scheme of Incentives for a subsidiary in the Industrial Infrastructure segment. In addition, lower export sales weighed on the profitability of its Industrial Products business during the reporting period. Separately, the company's board approved a Scheme of Arrangement and Amalgamation involving Thermax Bioenergy Solutions Private Limited, Thermax Cooling Solutions Limited and Thermax Limited.--IANS

BMW to cut around 8,000 jobs in Germany by 2027 amid weak demand and cost pressures

New Delhi, (IANS) German luxury carmaker BMW on Wednesday announced plans to cut several thousand jobs in Germany by the end of 2027 through a voluntary redundancy programme, becoming the latest automaker to reduce its workforce amid weakening demand, mounting cost pressures and a challenging transition to electric vehicles. The company said the severance programme, agreed with the works council, will primarily affect employees in its administration and development divisions, while production operations will remain unaffected.
