Senior advocate K Parameshwar sought Supreme Court's urgent intervention in quashing the illegal and arbitrary action of Bar Council of India (BCI) in seeking to coerce VC of Nalsar University, one of India's top law schools, to conduct an investigation and identify students who had opposed the CJI Surya Kant's participation in the convocation as chief guest and issuing the now-withdrawn threat that those identified would be denied registration for the licence to practice by all the state bar councils.

The CJI-led bench without even going through the petition filed by two former students of Nalsar, sought BCI's explanation on the process it adopted before passing the resolutions prior to issuing the two letters.

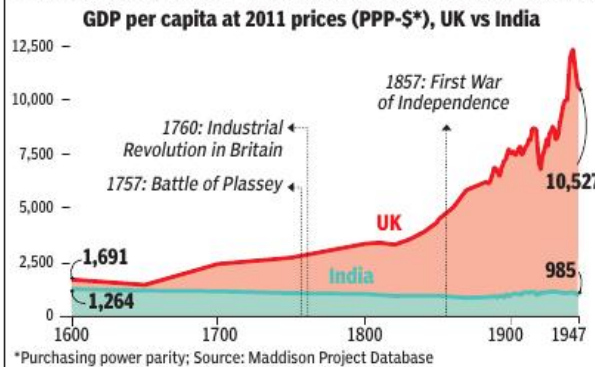
Trashing the BCI threat, CJI told Parameshwar to convey to the students "to get licences to practice at the earliest and begin their careers in Supreme Court. We will empanel them and give them legal aid cases. This will be our response to all those who intend to create impediments in their professional career."

He added, "We should be large-hearted. Even if someone makes a wrong statement at a young age, let it rest there. That does not mean they do not have a right to speak. During my student days, I was actively involved in many student activities. They have a right to protest peacefully, and no one can stop them. They have a fundamental right to freedom of speech and expression."

'Not Saying Univ Should Uninvite Him'

Hyderabad: Backed by the alumni and members of Cockroach Janta Party (CJP), Telangana, National Academy of Legal Studies and Research (Nalsar) students said they were firm on their demand that chief justice of India **Surya Kant** not attend the convocation as chief guest. However, they maintained that they did not plan to boycott the event or ask the varsity to withdraw the invitation.

"Our demand was not to invite him to the convocation. But since he has already been invited, there is not much we can do. However, we will not withdraw our demand," a student said.

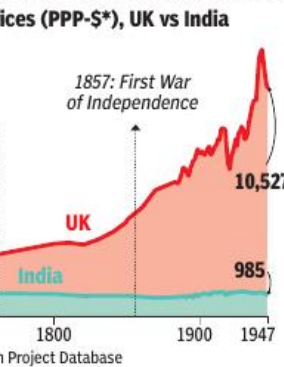
The students had on Aug 9 made a representation to the vice-chancellor against inviting the CJI, objecting to Supreme Court initially refusing to hear petitions on police brutality during the CJP protest.

Alumni members said the students were well within their rights to ask the varsity not to invite the CJI. "It is a justified demand made to their own administration and vice-chancellor. The demand was to reconsider the decision to invite the CJI, which is in line with Nalsar norms... It is not disrespectful to the office of the CJI itself," said Akhil Surya, a gold medallist at last year's Nalsar convocation.

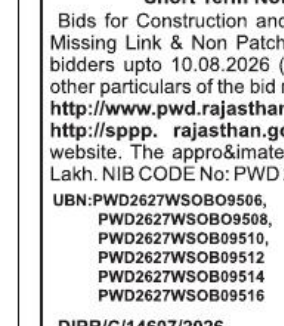

Be mindful of strong India-Italy ties, says MEA after Rahul's jibe at Modi & Meloni

New Delhi: The ministry of external affairs Friday urged everyone to be mindful of strong India-Italy ties and the need to be respectful to each other. The remark followed a controversy over Congress member of Parliament Rahul Gandhi as well as party neta Sandeep Dikshit's jibe at Prime Minister Narendra Modi on foreign policy that involved Italian PM Giorgia Meloni.



"We have strong ties with Italy. Our ties with Italy in recent years have expanded and strengthened in every which way, and it's important that, as part of diplomatic practice, we strengthen our ties, keeping in mind being respectful of each other. There's mutual understanding between the two sides," said spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal.

SC relief for Rahul in Savarkar case

Noting that there was no sanction to prosecute leader of opposition in Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi for his controversial remarks against V D Savarkar, Supreme Court Friday quashed proceedings against him initiated by a Lucknow court, reports **Amit Anand Choudhary**. Rahul had allegedly described Savarkar as "receiver of pension from Britishers" and "a servant of Britishers" at a news conference on Nov 17, 2022, following which an additional chief judicial magistrate in Lucknow took cognisance of offences under Sections 153A (promoting enmity) and 505 (public mischief) of IPC and issued summons to him. The SC, which had given an earful to Rahul in the last hearing for his remarks, concluded that criminal proceedings against him were untenable for want of sanction.
